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Full Report on Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories and Orders January 2014

Summary

New orders for manufactured goods in January, down three of the last four months, decreased \$3.3 billion or 0.7 percent to \$483.0 billion, the U.S. Census Bureau reported today. This followed a 2.0 percent December decrease. Excluding transportation, new orders increased 0.2 percent.

Shipments, down two consecutive months, decreased \$1.7 billion or 0.3 percent to \$490.7 billion. This followed a 0.3 percent December decrease.

Unfilled orders, up eleven of the last twelve months, increased \$0.3 billion to \$1,059.9 billion. This was at the highest level since the series was first published on a NAICS basis in 1992 and followed a 0.2 percent December increase. The unfilled orders-to-shipments ratio was 6.50, down from 6.52 in December.

Inventories, up thirteen of the last fourteen months, increased \$1.2 billion or 0.2 percent to \$637.7 billion. This was also at the highest level since the series was first published on a NAICS basis and followed a 0.5 percent December increase. The inventories-to-shipments ratio was 1.30, up from 1.29 in December.

New Orders

New orders for manufactured durable goods in January, down three of the last four months, decreased \$2.3 billion or 1.0 percent to \$225.0 billion, unchanged from the previously published decrease. This followed a 5.3 percent December decrease.

Transportation equipment, also down three of the last four months, drove the decrease, down \$4.1 billion or 5.7 percent to \$67.2 billion.

New orders for manufactured nondurable goods decreased \$0.9 billion or 0.4 percent to \$258.1 billion.

Shipments

Shipments of manufactured durable goods in January, down two consecutive months, decreased \$0.7 billion or 0.3 percent to \$232.6 billion, revised from the previously published 0.4 percent decrease. This followed a 1.7 percent December decrease.

Machinery, down following five consecutive monthly

increases, drove the decrease, down \$1.0 billion or 2.9 percent to \$34.6 billion.

Shipments of manufactured nondurable goods, down following two consecutive monthly increases, decreased \$0.9 billion or 0.4 percent to \$258.1 billion. This followed a 1.0 percent December increase. Chemical products, down two of the last three months, led the decrease, down \$0.6 billion or 1.0 percent to \$63.8 billion.

Unfilled Orders

Unfilled orders for manufactured durable goods in January, up eleven of the last twelve months, increased \$0.3 billion to \$1,059.9 billion, revised from the previously published 0.1 percent increase. This was at the highest level since the series was first published on a NAICS basis and followed a 0.2 percent December increase.

Machinery, up nine of the last ten months, drove the increase, up \$2.0 billion or 1.8 percent to \$112.1 billion.

Inventories

Inventories of manufactured durable goods in January, up nine of the last ten months, increased \$1.1 billion or 0.3 percent to \$389.1 billion, unchanged from the previously published increase. This was at the highest level since the series was first published on a NAICS basis and followed a 0.9 percent December increase.

Transportation equipment, up twenty of the last twenty-one months, led the increase, up \$1.1 billion or 0.9 percent to \$123.0 billion.

Inventories of manufactured nondurable goods, up following four consecutive monthly decreases, increased slightly to \$248.6 billion. This followed a 0.2 percent December decrease. Chemical products, up two consecutive months, drove the increase, up \$0.1 billion or 0.1 percent to \$81.1 billion.

By stage of fabrication, January materials and supplies increased 0.8 percent in durable goods and 0.5 percent in nondurable goods. Work in process increased 0.1 percent in durable goods and 1.0 percent in nondurable goods. Finished goods decreased slightly in durable goods and 0.7 percent in nondurable goods.

Figures in text are adjusted for seasonality, but not for inflation. Figures on new and unfilled orders exclude data for semiconductor manufacturing. This report is compiled from results of the U.S. Census Bureau's Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders (M3) survey. This survey provides statistics on manufacturers' value of shipments, new orders (net of cancellations), end-of-month order backlog (unfilled orders), end-of-month total inventory (at current cost or market value), and inventories by stage of fabrication (materials and supplies, work-in-process, and finished goods). The M3 includes approximately 4,300 reporting units. Units may be divisions of diversified large companies, large homogenous companies, or single-unit manufacturers in 89 industry categories. Due to the small monthly sample, these 89 categories have been combined into 65 publication levels. The survey methodology assumes that the month-to-month changes of the total operations of all establishments that make up the category. The current coverage levels in the survey show that reported data in the monthly survey represent approximately 60 percent of the shipments estimates at the total manufacturing level. Data published represent manufacturing in a calendar month. The data collection is based on a voluntary survey authorized by Title 13 of the United States Code.

The data presented in this release are based on data obtained from a panel of 4,300 reporting units and provide an indication of the activity within the manufacturing sector. The results differ from what would be obtained from a complete enumeration of all manufacturing companies. In addition, a different panel of 4,300 companies would yield different results. The M3 panel is comprised of companies with \$500 million or more in shipments and a limited number of smaller companies. From a statistical perspective, the panel is not a probability sample; therefore, the sampling errors that are normally provided with sample surveys cannot be measured. Nonsampling errors are attributable to many sources. The use of companies is one source of nonsampling error. The use of primarily large companies to represent the month-to-month movement of all companies is another potential source. Any corrections will be published in the full report. Corrections received after the full report will be released in the next month's advance report. Any revisions made later than two months will be reflected in the annual benchmark publication.

Notice of Revisions Due to Updated Seasonal Adjustment Models

On May 15, 2014, monthly seasonally adjusted data for Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders, based on the North American Industry Classification System, will be revised for January 1992 through March 2014. There will be no accompanying press release containing revised seasonally adjusted data for January through March of 2014, and historical data not seasonally adjusted will be unchanged. These revisions to the historical seasonally adjusted data will be based on the results of the recent annual review of the seasonal adjustment models. These updated models will also be used to produce seasonally adjusted data from the Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders Survey, beginning with the April 2014 Advance Report on Durable Goods scheduled for release on May 27, 2014 and the full report scheduled for release on June 3, 2014.
