

MONTHLY FULL REPORT ON MANUFACTURERS' SHIPMENTS, INVENTORIES AND ORDERS APRIL 2019

Release Number: CB 19-71 M3-2 (19)-04

June 4, 2019 — The U.S. Census Bureau announces the April full report on manufacturers' shipments, inventories and orders:





Summary

New orders for manufactured goods in April, down two of the last three months, decreased \$4.0 billion or 0.8 percent to \$499.3 billion, the U.S. Census Bureau reported today. This followed a 1.3 percent March increase. Shipments, down following two consecutive monthly increases, decreased \$2.7 billion or 0.5 percent to \$504.1 billion. This followed a 0.2 percent March increase. Unfilled orders, down two of the last three months, decreased \$0.6 billion or 0.1 percent to \$1,179.3 billion. This followed a 0.1 percent March increase. The unfilled orders-to-shipments ratio was 6.69, up from 6.61 in March. Inventories, up seven of the last eight months, increased \$1.8 billion or 0.3 percent to \$692.9 billion. This followed a 0.4 percent March increase. The inventories-to-shipments ratio was 1.37, up from 1.36 in March.

New Orders

New orders for manufactured durable goods in April, down two of the last three months, decreased \$5.2 billion or 2.1 percent to \$248.6 billion, unchanged from the previously published decrease. This followed a 1.7 percent March increase. Transportation equipment, also down two of the last three months, drove the decrease, \$5.3 billion or 5.9 percent to \$85.5 billion. New orders for manufactured nondurable goods increased \$1.2 billion or 0.5 percent to \$250.7 billion.

Shipments

Shipments of manufactured durable goods in April, down three of the last four months, decreased \$3.9 billion or 1.5 percent to \$253.4 billion, up from the previously published 1.6 percent decrease. This followed a 0.5 percent March decrease. Transportation equipment, down four consecutive months, led the decrease, \$3.7 billion or 4.1 percent to \$85.9 billion. Shipments of manufactured nondurable goods, up three consecutive months, increased \$1.2 billion or 0.5 percent to \$250.7 billion. This followed a 0.9 percent March increase. Petroleum and coal products, also up three consecutive months, led the increase, \$1.1 billion or 2.0 percent to \$56.2 billion.

Unfilled Orders

Unfilled orders for manufactured durable goods in April, down two of the last three months, decreased \$0.6 billion or 0.1 percent to \$1,179.3 billion, unchanged from the previously published decrease. This followed a 0.1 percent March increase. Transportation equipment, also down two of the last three months, led the decrease, \$0.4 billion or virtually unchanged to \$810.7 billion.

Inventories

Inventories of manufactured durable goods in April, up nine of the last ten months, increased \$1.7 billion or 0.4 percent to \$422.4 billion, unchanged from the previously published increase. This followed a 0.3 percent March increase. Transportation equipment, also up nine of the last ten months, led the increase, \$1.5 billion or 1.1 percent to \$136.1 billion. Inventories of manufactured nondurable goods, up four consecutive months, increased \$0.2 billion or 0.1 percent to \$270.5 billion. This followed a 0.5 percent March increase. Petroleum and coal products, also up four consecutive months, drove the increase, \$0.5 billion or 1.3 percent to \$42.2 billion. By stage of fabrication, April materials and supplies increased 0.1 percent in durable goods and decreased 0.2 percent in nondurable goods. Work in process increased 0.9 percent in durable goods and was virtually unchanged in nondurable goods. Finished goods were virtually unchanged in durable goods and increased 0.3 percent in nondurable goods.

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EXPLANATORY NOTES

Figures in text are adjusted for seasonality, but not for inflation. Figures on new and unfilled orders exclude data for semiconductor manufacturing.

"Virtually unchanged" indicates that the change is less than 0.05 percent for a percent increase or decrease.

Description of the survey

This report is compiled from results of the U.S. Census Bureau's Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders (M3) survey, which is a voluntary survey authorized by Title 13 of the United States Code. This survey provides statistics on a calendar-month basis for manufacturers' value of shipments, new orders (net of cancellations), end-of-month order backlog (unfilled orders), end-of-month total inventory (at current cost or market value), and inventories by stage of fabrication (materials and supplies, work-inprocess, and finished goods). Data published from the M3 survey are based on a panel of approximately 5,000 reporting units that represent approximately 3,100 companies and provide an indication of monthto-month change for the Manufacturing Sector. These reporting units may be divisions of diversified large companies, large homogenous companies, or single-unit manufacturers in 92 industry categories, which are combined into 65 publication levels due to the small monthly panel size. The survey methodology assumes that the month-to-month changes of the total operations of the reporting units in the M3 panel effectively represent the month-to-month movements of all establishments that make up the category. The companies for which shipments data are currently reported or imputed in the M3 survey represent approximately 64 percent of the total value of shipments for manufacturing establishments in the 2012 Economic Census, and these companies include almost two-thirds of the manufacturing companies with \$500 million or more in shipments in the 2012 Economic Census. The companies for which shipments data are currently reported in the M3 survey represent approximately 57 percent of the total value of shipments for manufacturing establishments in the 2012 Economic Census. Statistics based on the M3 panel differ from the results that would be obtained from a complete enumeration of all manufacturing companies. The M3 panel is not based on a probability sample; therefore, the sampling errors that are normally provided with sample surveys cannot be measured. Nonsampling errors are attributable to many sources. The use of company or divisional reports to estimate the monthly change for establishments is one source of nonsampling error. The use of primarily large companies to represent the month-to-month movement of all companies is another potential source. Any corrections will be published in the full report. Corrections received after the full report will be released in the next month's advance report. Any

Notice of Revisions and Changes Due to Updated Seasonal Adjustment Models

On May 16, 2019, monthly seasonally adjusted data for Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders, based on the North American Industry Classification System, were revised for January 2002 through March 2019. There was no accompanying press release containing revised seasonally adjusted data for January through March of 2019, and historical data not seasonally adjusted were unchanged. These revisions to the historical seasonally adjusted data were based on the results of the recent annual review of the seasonal adjustment models. Based on this review, the lists of series that are seasonally adjusted and not seasonally adjusted were updated. Three unfilled orders series and one total inventories series that have been adjusted are no longer seasonally adjusted. Conversely, two stage of fabrication series that have not been adjusted are now seasonally adjusted. These changes were implemented on May 16, 2019 and were used to produce seasonally adjusted data from the Manufacturers' Shipments,

Seasonally adjusted estimates include concurrent adjustments for holiday and trading-day differences, where appropriate, as well as seasonal variation, based on the results of the latest annual review of the model parameters. Estimates are not adjusted for price changes.

Estimates and percent changes of shipments for the semiconductor industry are included in computers and electronic products, and all other applicable aggregate totals.
